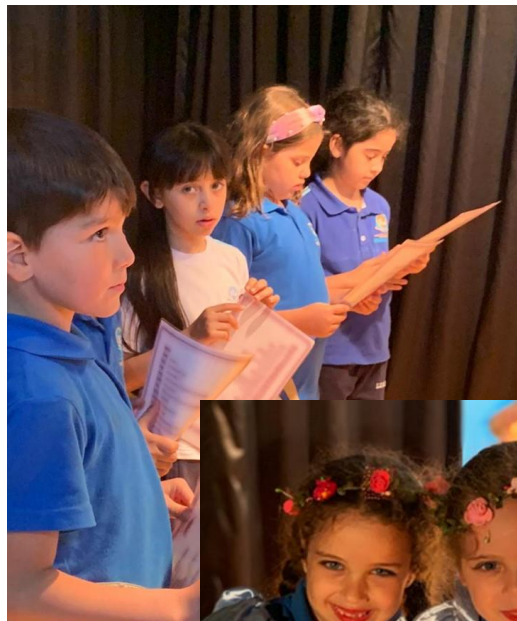

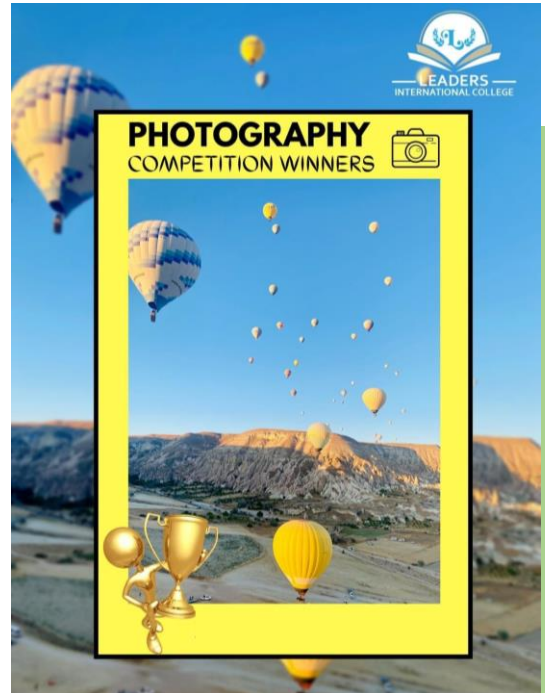

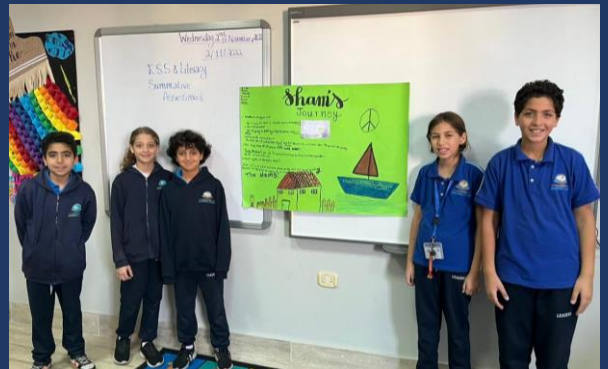
## EARLY YEARS JOBS DAY

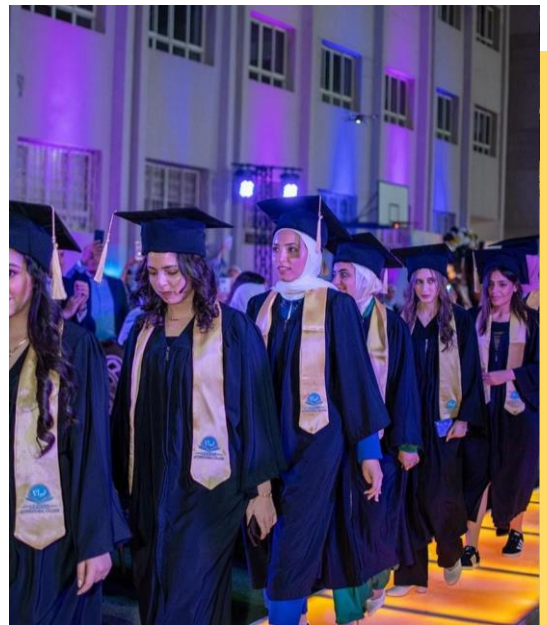
